Dite of these exemptions, any swimmer who achieves a record time at a competition that ognizes records at any level (regional, provincial, national etc, whether age group or open) not be recognized for that record unless the coach has advised the referee prior to the start he session that there is a possibility of the record being broken, and the referee insures that swimmer competes with competitors of the same gender for his/her heat. The event that mixed gender swims are permitted, the results must still be posted separately gender of swimmers.
